TMR – Southern Moreton Bay Ferry Terminals (Thursday & Friday)

I commenced works on the southern Moreton Bay ferry terminals upgrade project this week. Working under Jon Eames, I will be providing design management support to bring the drawings forward from preliminary design to detailed design as well as assisting in stakeholder management, budget and programme management, as well as providing technical advice throughout the tender phase.

What is your proudest moment at CPM?

My proudest moment with CPM would be successfully completing the bollard upgrade project for the Port of Brisbane (PBPL) which was a good challenge for me. I was able to complete the project on budget with minimal disruptions to shipping operations. This project was a major success for PBPL & the terminal operators as the wharf is now able to cater for larger vessels which means more revenue and greater operational flexibility/ operating efficiencies. The increased capacity of the wharf provides PBPL with the ability to cater for future shipping demands which is essential for the longevity of sustained shipping operations & securing long term lease agreements between PBPL & Terminal Operators.
